Summer Interns taking the Business as Mission (BAM) track will focus on how their college major or desired business profession integrates with faith in the workplace here in Bend, Oregon - with an integration of the more long-term vision of using business to bring Christ to the unreached.

BAM interns will spend 180 hours on site in a local business where they will fulfill a project expectation in the business (e.g. accountants in accounting; marketing students in the marketing sector, etc.) all the while learning how they can reach professional excellence in all they do. They will live out their faith by rubbing shoulders with fellow workers, making presentations, attending professional gatherings, accomplishing a specific task, and being mentored by an experienced business person. They will grow their talent for business and their passion for Jesus in the real world.

Interns can expect to grapple with issues of profitability, sustainability, creating value, and the development of spiritual capital in the workplace. They can expect business mentors to process their experiences on the job and also help develop an understanding of Jesus' command that we be his witnesses to the whole world.
