The Antioch Staff has a combined pastoral experience of over 40 years. We are a group of people who are passionate about training the next church leaders to go out and make a vital impact for the kingdom of God. Pastor interns will spend numerous hours with Antioch Pastoral Team and other pastors in the area to learn and grow in the art of pastoral ministry.

Teaching: Interns will be challenged to grow and refine their teaching skills. This will include shadowing a teaching pastor, aiding the pastor in research and collection of information for lessons, preparing several lessons of their own, teaching on a number of occasions, and going through a study program involving solid reading material on the subject.

Church Planting: This internship would entail close mentorship under Antioch's church leadership and exposure to other seasoned church planters. The internship would also require that interns be appointed as a director over a field of ministry interest that would be determined on an individual basis, after acceptance into the program.

Men's/Women's: The American Church is filled with men and women seeking to find meaning and deepen their relationship with God. Summer Interns will partner with Antioch's Men's leaders and Women's leaders to create meaningful ministries that not only help men and women grow in their faith but also empower them to obtain the calling God has placed before them.

Discipleship: Interns will gain experience in counseling, mentoring, and discipling college aged students, singles, and others within the men's and women's ministries at Antioch.

Community Life: Interns will hear the story of Antioch and see how the Lord has led us to establish the community life we have today. They will see the steps we took to get there, our view on home groups, outdoor groups, men's and women's groups, interest groups and learning groups.
